Resolutions taken in the IQAC meeting (20.11.2019):


Following decisions have been taken:


1. IQAC will submit a proposal for two days national workshop to NAAC. The tentative dates are scheduled to be 24-25, April 2020. The theme of the workshop as decided in the meeting is "*Issues and challenges in ensuring quality in higher education: A north-east perspective*".
2. IQAC will apply to DHE for *No Objection Certificate* to introduce certificate courses on
 - a. Spoken English
 - b. Vermi Composting
 - c. Mushroom Cultivation
 - d. Women's Studies
3. It is also resolved that a state level program on Gender Equity will be organized by Department of Sociology tentatively in the month of February 2020.
4. As resolved in the last meeting discussions for promotion of universal Values and Ethics with Dr. Dharendra Debnath and Dr. Tapas Roy Chowdhury as speakers will be organized by Department of Sanskrit in the month of February-March 2020.
5. A state level program on Value based Education will be organized by Department of Education in the month of February 2020.
6. Exam committee is given the responsibility to complete the data collection regarding Student Satisfaction Survey and NIRF from the students during exam session.
7. The formats for Academic and administrative audit (AAA) as prepared by IQAC has been accepted by the members in the meeting.

Follow up Actions:

1. IQAC submitted a proposal for two days national workshop to NAAC scheduled to be held on 24-25, April 2020 on the theme "*Issues and challenges in ensuring quality in higher education: A north-east perspective*". NAAC has accepted the proposal and sanctioned an amount of Rs. 100000/- for the program.
2. IQAC has already applied to DHE for *No Objection Certificate* to introduce certificate courses on Spoken English, Vermi Composting, Mushroom Cultivation, Women's Studies.
3. State level program on Gender Equity to be organized by Department of Sociology will be held on March 2020.
4. The programs for promotion of Values and Ethics and a state level program on Value based Education are under process and will be held in the month of March 2020.
5. Data collection regarding Student Satisfaction Survey and NIRF by Exam committee is in process.
6. The formats for Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) as prepared by IQAC has been accepted by the members in the meeting.
